SEPTEMBER 22, 2009

REGULAR SEPTEMBER SESSION

The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment. Present were: Jack Plathe, Chairman, Don Besch, Eugene Elsbecker, Don McGregor and Pam Wymore.

Motion by Besch and 2nd by Wymore to approve the agenda. Ayes: 4 Nays: 0 Motion carried. Absent: McGregor

Motion by Elsbecker and 2nd by Wymore to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read. Ayes: all Nays: none Motion carried unanimous.

Jack Bradley, Kossuth County Sanitarian was present to give a presentation of photos taken during his inspection of a Sexton Property. He explained that this building is a hazard and the Board needs to act on this due to a petition being filed. Todd Holmes explained what steps the Board needs to follow in order to act on Jack Bradley's determination of this property being hazardous. This item will be put back on the agenda on October 6th for action.

Public Discussion and Committee Reports were held followed by Drainage.

There was a Formal Hearing for H-K 2-36 Lat. B. These minutes can be found in the Drainage Minute Book.

Motion by Besch and 2nd by McGregor to approve Resolution #09-22-09-01 which provides for local authorities to establish and erect stop signs. Ayes: all Nays: none Motion carried unanimous.

KOSSUTH COUNTY RESOLUTION # 09-22-09-01

WHEREAS, Section 321.345 of the Code of Iowa provides for local authorities to establish and erect stop signs, and

WHEREAS, an engineering study has been completed by the Kossuth County Engineer's Office, and

WHEREAS, the following projects L-G(P60)--73-55 (grading), STP-S-C055(127)--5E-55 (resurfacing), and L-P(P-60)--73-55 (paving) have changed the transition between Garfield Street in LuVerne and 190th Avenue (Kossuth County Route P-60) from a curve to a Tee intersection where the majority of traffic flows thru the Tee intersection on 190th Avenue in a north - south direction, and

WHEREAS, the study indicates a need to install a stop sign on Garfield Street at the intersection of Garfield Street and 190th Avenue for westbound traffic and to remove the stop sign at said intersection for northbound traffic, previously established by resolution 11-10-08-01.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors:

That a stop sign be installed on Garfield Street at the intersection of Garfield Street and 190th Avenue (P60 near LuVerne) for westbound traffic, and remove the stop sign on 190th Avenue (P60 near LuVerne) at the intersection of Garfield Street and 190th Avenue for northbound traffic, previously established by resolution 11-10-08-01.

This resolution shall be in effect upon passage of this resolution and after stop signs are erected and removed.
