Motion by Casey and 2nd by Loss to approve the cigarette permits for Abate of Iowa, Inc. and Spring Valley Golf Course. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Casey and 2nd by Loss to authorize and give its permission to Lumen (CenturyLink), Des Moines, IA to bore approximately 1,000 feet of fiber optic cable in the north ditch of B55 (170th St), beginning approximately 2,000 feet east of 128th Avenue. Work will be in Section 30, Irvington Township. Permit number 05-14-2022 is on file in the Kossuth County Engineer's Office. Motion carried unanimously.
