### A RESOLUTION TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS; The currently approved Airport Layout Plan (ALP) for the Algona Municipal Airport identifies a runway extension of the main runway (Runway 12-30) to the southeast and this subject runway

extension requires that a portion of 100th Avenue between B40 and US 18 be closed in conjunction with the runway and runway safety areas; and

WHEREAS; The FAA is now requiring the displacement of existing Runway 12 to the southeast to provide adequate runway approach clearance over existing Highway 18; and

WHEREAS; This displacement will leave less than adequate available runway length to accommodate existing and future aircraft operations; and

The necessary extension of the runway to the southeast will require that a portion of 100<sup>th</sup> WHEREAS; Avenue lying inside the Algona City limits and lying in Kossuth County be closed and vacated; and

WHEREAS; The City of Algona, is scheduling a letting to receive bids for the construction of the runway displacement in March of 2022; and

WHEREAS; The Algona City Council and Kossuth County Board of Supervisors have agreed to seek the road closure and vacation at a time consistent with construction of the runway extension and safety area; and

WHEREAS; The portion of 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue that would be vacated by Kossuth County is described as part of the road located between sections 3 and 4, T-95N, R-29W of the 5th P.M., Cresco Township, Kossuth County, Iowa being 66 feet in width, 33 feet on each side of the following described centerline;

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Section 3; thence north approximately 1,749.51 feet along the section line between said Sections 3 and 4 to the southeast corner of Parcel "E" of Plat of Survey recorded in the Kossuth County Recorder's Office in Book 2020 Page 1041 and the point of beginning, thence continuing north approximately 1,194.17 feet to the northwest corner of Parcel 2 of Plat of Survey recorded in the Kossuth County Recorder's Office in Book 2020 Page 860 and thence terminating, and

The portion of 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue that would be vacated by the City of Algona is described as part of the road located between sections 3 and 4, T-95N, R-29W of the 5th P.M., Cresco Township, Kossuth County, Iowa being 66 feet in width, 33 feet on each side of the following described centerline;

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Section 3; thence north approximately 2,076.49 feet along the section line between said Sections 3 and 4 to the northeast corner of Parcel "E" of Plat of Survey recorded in the Kossuth County Recorder's Office in Book 2020 Page 1041 and the point of beginning, thence continuing north approximately 867.19 feet to the northwest corner of Parcel 2 of Plat of Survey recorded in the Kossuth County Recorder's Office in Book 2020 Page 860 and thence terminating, and

The Kossuth County Board of Supervisors have previously passed Resolution 11-16-21-01 on November 16, 2021 that set a Public Hearing for the Vacation of the previously mentioned portion of 100th Avenue and now desires to rescind that resolution, and

The Kossuth County Board of Supervisors and the City Council of Algona Must act together must act jointly to vacate this portion of roadway,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; That a Joint Public Hearing of the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors and Algona City Council be held on January 11, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Algona City Hall to hear support or objections from the public concerning this proposed road vacation.
