Motion by Plathe and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Besch to approve and authorize the chair to sign the Annual Financial Assurance Report for Kossuth County Sanitary Landfill for FY2011. Motion carried.

Motion by Wymore and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elsbecker to award a contract to Mathy Construction, Co., Onalaska, WI, for \$3,242,870.17 to construct the following HMA projects that were let at the Iowa Department of Transportation on March 20, 2012: STP-S-C055(131)--5E-55, FM-C055(139)--55-55, FM-C055(140)--55-55, LFM-(138)--7X-55 and L-CO(141)--73-55 and further to approve and authorize the chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign contracts and bonds when the appropriate contract documents are returned to the Kossuth County Engineer. Motion by Elsbecker and  $2^{nd}$  by Plathe to terminate farm lease agreement with Don Hagen for approximately 132 acres of land in the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 95 North, Range 31 West of the  $5^{th}$  P.M., Palo Alto County, Iowa dated December 21, 2010 and to approve and authorize the

chair to sign a new lease with new terms with Don Hagen for the described land. Motion carried 4 to 1 Besch: NO

Motion by Elsbecker and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Besch that the Board of Supervisors of Kossuth County, Iowa, does hereby authorize and give its permission to Winnebago Cooperative Telephone Association, Lake Mills, IA, to bury a fiber optic cable in the right of way and bore all intersection roads. Work will begin at a pedestal in the SW corner of Section 13, Lincoln Township, running in the north right of way of Highway 9 (under separate permit), boring under 240<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 230<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 220<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 210<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 200<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Highway 9. The burying of the fiber optic cable will continue in the west right of way of 200<sup>th</sup> Avenue, boring under 425<sup>th</sup> Street, 420<sup>th</sup> Street and working in the south right of way of 420<sup>th</sup> Street to 1908 420<sup>th</sup> Street. Work will be in Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19 and 30 of Lincoln Township. Permit number 04-09-2012 is on file in the Kossuth County Engineer's Office. Motion carried.
