WHEREAS, the mentioned housing subdivisions main entrance / exit is adjacent to secondary roads, and

WHEREAS, an engineering study has been completed by the Kossuth County Engineer's Office, and

WHEREAS, the study indicates a need for traffic that exits from all subdivisions' main entrances onto Kossuth County roads stop at the intersection of the entrance and the Kossuth County road,

WHEREAS, Section 321.345 of the Code of Iowa provides for local authorities to establish and erect stop signs.

- 6. The two intersections of Country Estates Subdivision entrance and Hungry Hollow Road located in section 14 of Cresco Township.
- 7. The intersection of the Southdale Subdivision entrance and Call Park Road located in section 14 of Cresco
