## Public Hearing Construction Permit Application Paul & Josh Broesder NENE Section 18 Plum Creek Township

Motion by Besch and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wymore to open the public hearing regarding the new construction permit for Paul & Josh Broesder in the NENE Section 18 of Plum Creek Township. Chairman Plathe called for a roll call vote: Besch: yes, McGregor: yes, Tjarks: yes, Wymore: yes, Plathe: yes

Public comments were received from Kendall Stumme and Ron Reefer. Kendall Stumme was representing Kossuth County Conversation and stated that this is a year round Public Use Area. Ron Reefer was speaking on behalf of the Walleye Club and also stated that this was a year round Public Use Area.

Motion by Besch and  $2^{\rm nd}$  by Tjarks to close the public hearing regarding the new construction permit for Paul & Josh Broesder in the NENE Section 18 of Plum Creek Township. Chairman Plathe called for a roll call vote: Besch: yes, McGregor: yes, Tjarks: yes, Wymore: yes, Plathe: yes

Motion by Tjarks and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Besch to recommend to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources the **disapproval** by Resolution #09-17-13-01 of the construction permit application for Paul & Josh Broesder in the NENE Section 18 Plum Creek Township due to them not meeting the requirements on the Master Matrix scoring system per Steve Anderson. This is also due to them **not meeting** the Chapter 65 rules. The Board has requested that Amber Garman send notice to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors adopted recommendation. Chairman Plathe called for a roll call vote: Besch: yes, McGregor: yes, Tjarks: yes, Wymore: yes, Plathe: yes

WHEREAS, the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors has adopted the Master Matrix for the purpose of scoring construction applications to provide an opportunity for local input and

WHEREAS, The Master Matrix Delegate, Steve Anderson has informed the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors that he scored this matrix differently than the Master Matrix filed in the Kossuth County Auditor's Office on August 16, 2013. The change was to Matrix Item #2. Applicant is claiming 30 points and Steve has allowed 0 points due to it being only 2050 feet from the Plum Creek Wildlife Area.

WHEREAS, the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors has **not approved** the Master Matrix submitted on August 16, 2013. The score of this facility is 455 points.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors Hereby recommends to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources **disapproval** of the construction permit application for Paul & Josh Broesder Site in the NE NE of Section 18 of Plum Creek Township due to it not meeting the Chapter 65 rules.

Work will involve burying a 2" and 1" duct across Call Park Road approximately 2,330' south of Hungry Hollow Road at 1902 Call Park Road. Work will be in Section 14, Cresco Township. Permit number 09-46-2013 is on file in the Kossuth County Engineer's Office. Motion carried.

Motion by Wymore and 2<sup>nd</sup> by McGregor that the Board of Supervisors of Kossuth County, Iowa, does hereby authorize and give its permission to Algona Municipal Utilities, Algona, IA, to re-locate overhead electric pole. Work will involve moving pole and installing 2 new anchors in the north right of way of 250<sup>th</sup> Street and River Road. Work will be in Section 13, Union Township. Permit number 09-47-2013 is on file in the Kossuth County Engineer's Office. Motion carried.

Discussion with Kossuth County Auditor was followed by Board Discussion and Committee Reports.

Ted Burghoff of Rock Island Clean Line was present to discuss a County Land Easement for Parcel #680-26-02-300-005 in Reverdale Township Section 2.
