Charissa has \$12,071.40 EMPG ARPA funds that will be received once the UTV is purchased. She has obtained \$8850 in donations and through the KEPT Healthcare \$17700. For total of \$38621.40. I will need to do the amendment for \$20,921.40. She is also requesting additional \$5000 for salaries to cover expenses that were paid out to Dave Penton during his time on call and to offset her salary that was budgeted under 911.

A motion was made by Kevin McPeak to approve budget amendment with a second from Wendy Zielske- roll call taken of the Commission Board- motion carried.

The board reviewed and discussed the By-Laws with changes and additions made. Decision to approve By-laws at the July meeting once changes have been made to the document.

Charissa discussed with the Commission the need for a trailer for the new Can-AM UTV trailer- She reports an estimated cost is anywhere between \$7000-\$10000 and would like it to be enclosed so equipment can be stored in the trailer such as the drone, chainsaws, etc. Charissa talked with Ben Eischen who quoted a trailer for \$11,500. Commission Board requested to continue to search and provide update at the next meeting.
