RESOLUTION 07-1-25-02

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor to periodically transfer sums from the General Basic and Rural Services Basic Funds to the Secondary Road Fund during the 25-26 Fiscal Budget Year, and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.429, Code of Iowa, as follows:

Section 1:	The total maximum transfer from the General Basic fund to the Secondary Road Fund For Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, shall not exceed the sum \$300,728 and the total Maximum transfer from the Rural Services Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2025, shall not exceed the sum of \$2,536,209. The total max transfer from Rural Services Basic Fund to the Secondary Road fund for L.O.S.T. (Local Option Sales Tax) for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2025, shall not exceed the sum of \$1,000,000.
Section 2:	Within 3-10 days of being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, state Replacements against levied property taxed, mobile home taxes, military service tax Credit replacements, or to the General Basic or Rural Services Basic Funds, the Auditor Shall order a transfer from said fund to the Secondary Road.
Section 3:	The amount of the transfer required by Section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment Made under Section 2 to the General Basic or Rural Services Basic fund, respectively, Multiplied by the ratio of said funds total maximum transfer to the Secondary Road Fund, to the sum of said funds total current property tax levy, total mobile home taxes, Total military service tax credit replacements, and total livestock credit replacements.
Section 4:	Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this resolution to the Secondary Road Fund shall not exceed the amounts specified in Section 1.
Section 5:	Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution, the amount of any Transfer shall not exceed available fund balances in the transferring fund.

Section 6: The Auditor is directed to correct her books when said operating transfers are made and To notify the County Treasurer and County Engineer of the amounts of said transfers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors declare this resolution adopted July 1, 2025.
