Communication to/from the Commission: Director Green discussed the passage of HF 250 and 259 and Commissioner Brandt led a discussion around the new legislation on funding for service organizations to assist/backfill VSOs. The enrollment of these service organizations is low and the funds used to support VSOs in the past just aren't there anymore.
  - b. Director Green informed the Commission that the recruitment of new drivers for the department to drive veterans to appointments continues to be a work-in-progress. He is without any drivers at the moment.
