

**Kossuth County, Iowa
Secondary Road Department**

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In 2026, the U.S. Department of Transportation will award up to \$350 million in Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) grants to support critical infrastructure projects across the country. CHBP is a nationally competitive grant program that provides funding for transportation bridge infrastructure.

The Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT), in partnership with 20+ counties and cities, is applying to receive funding to rebuild 32 bridges in poor condition across the state. These bridge replacement projects would improve safety, increase communities' connection to nearby areas, such as schools, businesses, hospitals, and parks, provide easier access for freight and agricultural-related movement, and allow for economic growth.

Kossuth County has two bridges that will be included in the CHBP grant application. One of the bridges is located on route P64 (150 avenue) between 260 street and 280 street. The other bridge is route R14 (240 avenue) between 290 street and 300 street.

We need your assistance by telling us how you use the current structures and your thoughts on potential wider, safer bridges that can carry heavier loads.
