**RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ALONG
KOSSUTH COUNTY HUNGRY HOLLOW ROAD**

Kossuth County Resolution No. 08-18-26-02

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Iowa Code Sections 321.255 and 321.285 of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS, such an investigation has been completed by the Kossuth County Engineer,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KOSSUTH COUNTY that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs be erected at the locations described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Hungry Hollow Road and Call Park Road , thence easterly and southerly approximately 5,280 feet, 35 miles per hour.
